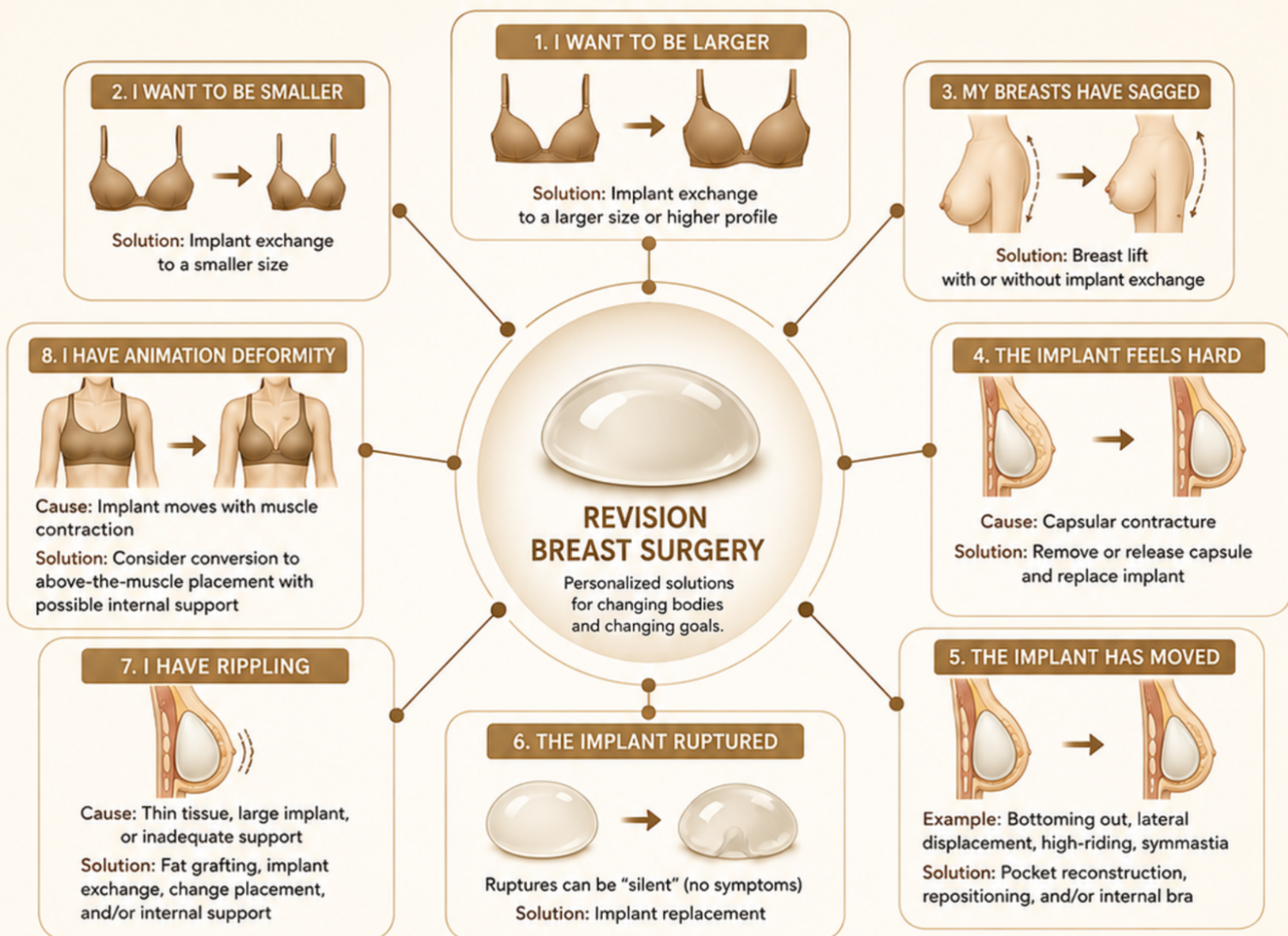


Why Might I Need Revision Surgery?
